PROMOTERS CONDITIONS

Invited Clubs: Limited to 4 invited clubs. All 4 clubs will be limited to a set number of swimmers

overall based on the pool providers' recommendations prior to the competition date.

At the moment the clubs have agreed to no more than 200 swimmers total

Entries: -A per swimmer ENTRY FEE of £25 per series.

-Swimmers will be allowed to enter with NT but a time (from licensed competition or

club time trials) is preferred.

-Should entries exceed the allotted time available at each pool, the slowest swimmers in each age group will be scratched until the maximum number of swimmers is reached. (Should another event not reach capacity, a more popular

event could exceed this amount).

MEET This meet is a Level 4 Licensed Meet – number 4LR26; 4LR26; 4LR26

FACILITIES Northolt Leisure Centre, Ealing. 25m Competition Pool - 8 Lanes - Mini Anti-wave

Lane Ropes - Hy-Tek Meet Administration- Electronic Timing- Secondary Strobe

Light will be used for starts (ARES Timing Starters Box).

EVENTS All events are Heat Declared Winner. Heats will be seeded according to entry times,

slowest to fastest.

AGE GROUPS Age will be based on year of birth/age at Dec 31st, 2026.

Competition open for swimmers aged 8 (2018 born) to swimmers aged 12 (2014

born).

The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a

swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

SWIM ENGLAND Swimmers must be Swim England registered at a minimum of Club Train (category 1)

and have a Swim England registration number.

AWARDS No awards will be available for events, although spot prizes may be awarded to heat

winners throughout the day.

WITHDRAWAL This meet will operate as a **CARDLESS** meet. Entries will be pre-seeded before the

meet. Any withdrawals must be made 35 minutes before the start of each session at

the withdrawal desk.

Should a swimmer be withdrawn by mistake, the swimmer shall be allowed to swim in unallocated lanes in the earlier heats in the same event if available. If the mistake is

on the part of the Promoter then the swimmer will swim in his/her proper place.

SPECTATORS' FEE Northolt will also a limited number of spectators for £3 per person on a first come first

served basis.

ENTRY FORMS All entries shall be done via Hy-Tek Meet and Team manager software.

ENTRY FEES £25.00 per swimmer, per series.

GDPR By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required

by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information. The personal information supplied with your entry will be retained securely and will only be used for the legitimate purposes of running the event. This data will be shared by form of results with Swim England (Rankings) and the clubs who have entered the meet. A full copy of the results will be published on the website after the meet. Please be aware that links from our website may take you to external websites that are not covered by our policies. Please ensure that you review their privacy policies before any data is submitted. If any persons want to exercise their right to erasure or processing of their personal data they will need to make a written request to the promoter. We will only hold competition data for 12 months after which it will be

destroyed and erased from our systems.

Photo/Video Capture ESC reminds all those attending that the meet is under the pool operator's

photographic policy. Anyone wishing to use a cameras, video or digital image capturing devices (including mobile phones) that they should only do so after reference to their obligations and the recommendations laid down in Wavepower 2024, the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy & Procedures and other Swim England Photography guidance. You are reminded that Flash photography is NOT

permitted at the start of any heat.

With respect to changing rooms, any use by any person of a mobile phone or device is prohibited from the point of entry to a changing room until after exiting the changing room. In practice this means that any device must be in a bag or pocket, it must not be visible. There are no exemptions to this rule so if someone has an issue, they cannot use the device in the changing room; their need must be solved in

some other way.

WAVEPOWER Clubs must ensure there are enough adults (Coaches and Team Managers with the

correct ratios to the number of attending swimmers) on poolside with valid passes to provide adequate supervision in accordance with Swim England's Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy, and with reference to their obligations and the

recommendations laid down in Wavepower 2024, the Swim England Child Safeguarding

Policy & Procedures. (Swim England Supervision-ratios-policy)
